### The Poor Knights Islands Diving – one of the world's best diving spot

The Poor Knights Islands are a Nature Reserve and Marine Reserve. These are the highest levels of protection afforded in NZ, and it means the Islands are very precious. There is a “no take, no break” policy – resulting in you getting to experience the waters at their best! (We're not biased!!)

We meet at 8am on the morning of your dive at our shop in Tutukaka (180 km from Auckland), returning to the marina around 4pm. The journey to the Knights takes about an hour, and on the way out the crew will have a chat to you regarding your diving history and what you would like to get out of the day. You can choose to dive in a group led by one of our experienced instructors, or, if you have a few dives under your belt and are confident in the water you can explore independently as a buddy team.

We do two dives at the Knights, and in the surface interval we go for a tour around the Islands, checking out the amazing scenery, the magnificent archways, cliffs and caves – including Riko Riko Cave – the largest known sea bit of independent exploring.

The cost of your day would be as follows:

2 dive day, full equipment hire: US\$189

2 dive day, tanks and weights only: US\$147

2 dive day, own equipment: US\$110

Sightseeing, snorkeling, kayaking: US\$110

We have complimentary tea, coffee and soup on the boat for after your dives!

We can also arrange lunch for you for an extra US\$10. If you'd like this, just let us know when you confirm your booking, and whether you'd prefer the ham or vegetarian option.

When you do book, we need the dive information for each diver individual. Please let us know:

How many dives each has done

When the last dive was

Where each has done most of their diving

What each certification level is.

For those without their own transport we have a shuttle service between Whangarei and Tutukaka.
