DAY

01

: NOUMEA / KONE (265 km, 3 h)

9 a.m.: Pick up your rental car (category B for 2 persons or C for 3 persons) – Unlimited Kilometers and full insurance. Meet the rental car agent in the lobby of the hotel

In the morning, departure to the North of the Main Land. First stop will be a visit to the niaouli distillery at Boulouparis - The niaouli tree is unique to New Caledonia and its essence is used in perfumes and medicinal products. Head towards Bourail, and en route visit Fort Teremba (entry fee not included). You'll learn a lot about the region when you visit this ancient military base, built by convicts at the end of the 19th century.

Travel through Moindou village, once a coal-mining centre. Then, after Arab Hill (col des arabes), stop at the New Zealand cemetery where the graves of soldiers who died during the Pacific battles in World War 2 are beautifully maintained.

On arrival at Bourail, visit the beach and the "Roche Percée", a spectacular cliff pierced by caves, together with the "Bonhomme" rock formation, an enormous hard quartz monolith carved by the waves. See the view over the Baie des Tortues (Turtle Bay), a pretty beach bordered by pine trees.

We suggest you continue to Poé Beach where you could have lunch at the camping (not included) and enjoy the beautiful, unspoilt white sand beach.

In the end of the afternoon you will arrive to Koné, the capital of the Northern Province.

Overnight at Hotel Hibiscus in Tropical Garden room (pool view room if 3 persons).

DAY

02

: KONE / HIENGHENE (120 km, 2h)

Continental breakfast at your hotel

An opportunity today for you to see the "Heart of Voh", immortalised in the world-famous photograph by Yann Arthurs Bertrand, where the different heights within the mangrove form the shape of a heart.

We suggest lunch in Voh or Koné. In the afternoon, road to Hienghène by the « Koné – Tiwaka » transversal.

Arriving in Hienghène from the South, you'll drive along the Lindéralique Rocks, impressive black limestone cliffs which are up to 60m high.

Arrival at Koulnoué Village at the end of the day. Think about booking your excursion for the next day.

DAY

03

: HIENGHENE

Buffet breakfast in the hotel

Optional excursion. From your hotel, enjoy an easy, short bushwalk, accompanied by a guide who will explain the different species of flora that you encounter along the way. The track will take you to the Lindéralique lagoon, where you'll board a motorised pirogue for a close-up visit of the famous limestone rocks and their legends.

Lunch not included

In the afternoon, why not visit Hienghène village? Jean-Marie Tjibaou was from here, and the Museum gives a good insight into the region. You could also go to the Belvédère, the best point to see both the spectacular scenery and the rock formations in Hienghène Bay. From this vantage point you can admire not only the "Broody Hen" and the "Sphinx" in the centre of the bay and the islets and contrasting colours of the lagoon, but also Mount Panié, New Caledonia's highest peak (1,628m).

Overnight at Koulnoué Village (bungalow)

DAY

04

: HIENGHENE / POINDIMIE (73 Km / 1h)

Buffet breakfast in the hotel

In the morning, road to Poindimie. Drive along the coast road with its rivers, valleys and views over the lagoon.

Lunch not included

The afternoon, enjoy the white sandy beach in front of the hotel or go for a walk in Amoa or Tchamba valley.

Overnight at the Tiéti Tera Beach Resort in a Tropical Garden Bungalow

DAY

05

: POINDIMIE / SARRAMEA (208 Km)

Buffet breakfast at your hotel

Road to Sarramea.

On the trip, stop at the beautiful Bâ waterfall (cascade de Bâ) at Houailou and its 15m diameter natural water hole.

Crossing the mountain by way of Fruit Bat Pass (col des Roussettes)

Overnight at the EVASION Hotel, bungalow accommodation

DAY

06

: SARRAMEA / NOUMEA (110 Km / 2h)

Continental breakfast at your hotel

Road to Noumea

After La Foa, turn left towards the Oua Tom tribal village. There Marie Georgette can welcome you for a local meal !

After lunch, take the time to look around the tribe and then La Foa village before continuing on to Noumea

Return to Noumea and drop off your car rental before 6 p.m. at your hotel

DAY TRIP ON THE ILE OF PINES - Wednesday

Seat in coach transfer to Noumea's wharf

Breakfast on board of the ferry Aremiti 4: 1 hot drink and 1 croissant.

On leaving Port Moselle at first light, admire Noumea and the beautiful bays of Orphelinat, Baie des Citrons and famous Anse Vata as you begin your cruise across the largest lagoon in the world.

Pass by Mont Dore and various small islands, including pine-covered Porcupine Islet, then experience a majestic arrival into the Woodin Canal, which separates the main island of New Caledonia from Ouen Island.

The pleasures of the Pacific Ocean await you as you exit the Woodin Canal. Enjoy sailing towards the Isle of Pines across the planet's largest ocean. Marvel at the beauty of the coral reefs and the great cascades of foam where the Pacific swells break over them.

After a magical two hour spectacle, the Isle of Pines' landmark pure white sand beaches will appear, edging the turquoise waters along Kuto Bay.

Memories of this unforgettable cruise will remain with you forever.

At the end of XIX, this islet was a convict settlement, 3 000 prisoners were deported over there.

Local Name: KUNIE

After disembarking the Ferry boat, meet Edmond, your tour guide for the day.

The visit of the island will start with the white sandy bay of Kuto.

You will then stop at the old penal colony vestiges and be in the middle of the Kunié Island history.

Edmond will take you towards the north of the Island and make a stop at Oro Bay where you will enjoy the magnificent natural swimming pool and admire the colourful fishes.

Edmond will guide you through the humid forest towards Koungny local restaurant where you will enjoy your lunch on the waterfront (local specialities).

On your way back to the harbour, Edmond will drive through Vao Village, the only village of the island. Its church, "Notre Dame de l'Assomption" was built in 1860.

Transfer to the Kuto wharf and back to the boat for Nouméa.

Arrival at Nouméa late afternoon and transfer to your hotel Le Surf.

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

DAY

04

NOUMEA/SARRAMEA (121 Km) - Thursday

Buffet breakfast at your hotel

In the morning, meet your guide in the lobby of your hotel. Leave the hotel and climb Ouen Toro Hill for a panoramic view over Noumea and seawards to the tropical islets and blue waters protected by the barrier reef.

From Ouen Toro, drive along the palm-lined Promenade Pierre Vernier, with its views out to the surrounding islands and the lagoon. Visit the suburb of Faubourg Blanchot and pass the Military Barracks at the top of Avenue de la Victoire.

Head for the colourful and lively Noumea markets, where you'll see the many types of reef and deep sea fishes, from Marlin and Tuna to Sardines and Parrot-fish, a large variety of local vegetables and fruits plus displays of local arts and crafts.

After the markets, continue to the City Museum where you will learn everything about the Caledonian capital!

Enjoy a full tour of Coconut Square, the heart of Nouméa, where, in season, the flame trees color the town red. Continue past the city's shops to the FOL (local arts building) for a magnificent view over the city.

You will then exit Nouméa and head up north. First stop will be a visit to the Niaouli Distillery at Boulouparis - The Niaouli tree is common in New Caledonia and its essence is used in perfumes and medicinal products.

Lunch at « la petite ferme » in Pocquereux. Menu drinks included. You will visit the farm after lunch to discover the Caledonian culture.

Continue onto Sarraméa, one of the smallest regions of New Caledonia and check in your hotel.

You will then cross the street to visit a coffee plantation on the Merenki property.

Mme Bourdeau will welcome you and give explanation about the methods of coffee growing. You will then have the opportunity to taste it and even buy some, as a nice souvenir from New Caledonia!

There is also a small walk accessible to anyone, on a trail that leaves behind the hotel. You will reach the "Trou Feuillet" a water hole after 15 minutes walk and you will there have the opportunity to swim.

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

Night in bungalow at Hotel Evasion.

SARRAMEA / POINDIMIE (208 KM) - Friday

Continental breakfast at your hotel.

Head towards Bourail, and on the way visit Fort Teremba. You'll learn a lot about the region when you visit this ancient military base, which was built by convicts at the end of the 19th Century.

Lunch at Auberge de Moindou. Menu drinks excluded.

Travel through Moindou village, once a coal-mining centre. Then, after Arab Hill (col des arabes), stop at the New Zealand Cemetery where the graves of soldiers who died during the Pacific battles in World War 2 are beautifully maintained.

As you enter Bourail, you'll see a lovely, old stone building which houses the Bourail Museum.

You will drive through « Col des Roussettes », and then stop at the waterfall Bâ at Houailou, famous for its natural 15m wide hole.

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

Night at the hotel Tiéti Tera in a deluxe tropical room in a garden bungalow.

Free morning; enjoy the beautiful beach opposite your hotel.

Lunch "chez Simone". Local specialties, drinks not included.

In the afternoon, drive along the East Coast, you can admire rivers, valleys and look-out of the lagoon!

After a one hour drive, you will reach Hienghène, the village of Jean Marie Tjibaou. Continue to the Belvédère, the best point to see both the spectacular scenery and the rock formations in Hienghène Bay. From this vantage point you can admire not only the "Broody Hen" and the "Sphinx" in the centre of the bay and the islets and contrasting colours of the lagoon, but also Mount Panié, New Caledonia's highest peak (1,628m).

Discover as well the rocks of Linderalique and "le billet de 500".

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

Night at Koulnoué Village, Bungalow

HIENGHENE / KONE (120 KM) - Sunday

Buffet breakfast at your hotel

Around 8.30 am you will be heading to the Werap tribe where you will have the opportunity to live a unique moment of immersion in the Melanesian culture. The members of the tribe will welcome you for various workshops.

From 9.30 to 11.30 am, participate in the braiding, sculpting and "bougna" making workshops.

At 11.30 am, everyone will gather for lunch. Taste Bougna, a traditional kanak meal wrapped in banana leaves, and cooked under hot stones. Drinks not included.

After lunch go for a walk in the fields of the tribe.

In the afternoon (around 3.00 pm) take the cross-mountain road "Tiwaka - Koné" to the East Coast. Enjoy the imposing scenery and the tribal villages nestled in the heart of the valleys.

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

Night at the Koniambo Hotel – standard room.

08

KONE / NOUMEA (274 KM) - Monday

Buffet breakfast at your hotel

Departure in the morning towards Nouméa

Stop at the « Roche Percée », spectacular cliffs riddled with caves, and a tunnel pierced by the tides. The « Bonhomme » standing guard, an enormous monolith of hard quartz, sculptured by the waves and perched precariously on an angle. Also you will see Turtle Bay, a lovely beach surrounded by colonial pines.

Lunch at La Nera. Menu drinks excluded.

You will reach Nouméa in the afternoon.

Dinner at the restaurant of your hotel. Menu drinks excluded.

Flight Noumea / Ouvea

Ouvea is one of the most beautiful Pacific atoll with a 25 km beach of pristine white sands on the west coast. On the east coast, the island is protected from the open sea by the limestone cliffs and high coral rocks. Ouvea has been named "the island next to Paradise" thanks to a Japanese writer.

Old name of Ouvéa: Iaaï

To do/To see in Ouvea :

- the district of Saint Joseph and its church, famous for its wooden ceiling chapel shaped like a baby's crib and the Kohu-wood chair dating from 1912
- the famous Ouvea parrots, a protected endemic species
- the Cong-Ouloup caves. Legends and a superb view from the top of the cliffs accompany this trip. Bring a torch and book a guide.
- the Mouli bridge, built in 1984, joins the island of Mouli with the main island.
- the magnificent 25 km long Mouli beach
- the coconut oil distillery, located in the Wadrilla tribal village, in the district of Fayaoué.

- Queen Hortense's Cave

- N'ga peak, 262 meters high. Approximately one hour walking will bring you to one of the most beautiful views of the island.
- Gadgi beach

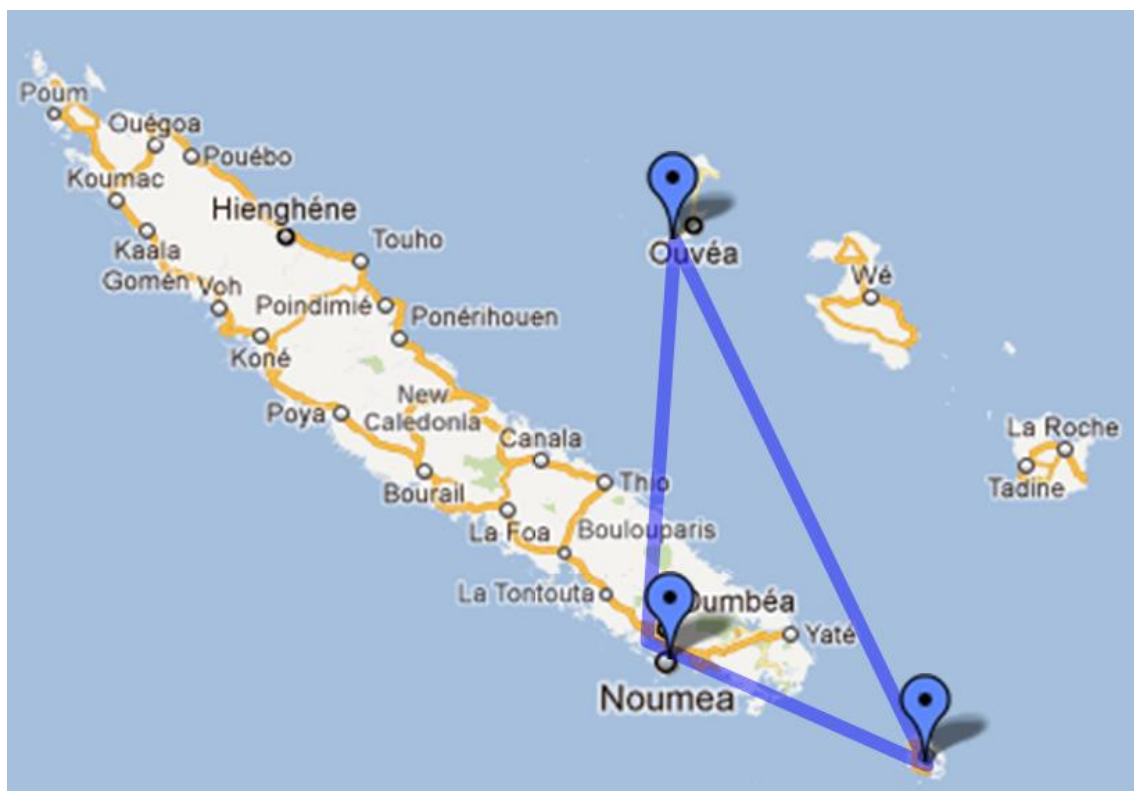
